The Australian Federal Police are responsible for providing police services to the community of Christmas Island. Their roles and duties are similar to that of State Police and they also undertake:

- Speed Checks & Breathalyzer tests
- Land & marine search & rescue co-ordination

Hospital Phosphate Hill Road Ph: 9164 8333

The hospital is open 24 hours for medical emergencies, advice & treatment and is located at Phosphate Hill Rd. Other services include:

- Emergency callouts by a nurse (or if required, a doctor)
- A voluntary St. Johns Ambulance Service which operates on a 24 hour callout basis
- Appointments for Doctor Consultations - Weekdays 7.30am - 4.00pm

63% of Christmas Island is National Park, providing visitors access to unique rain forest and rugged landscapes by way of 4WD tracks and walking paths. Please be aware of the following:

- There may be some road closures during crab migrations
- If you find an injured bird - contact or bring into Parks
- Crab Crossing - grid structures that allow migrating crabs to cross under roads
