**ROAD WORKS – MURRAY RD.
DIVERSION BETWEEN SCHOOL AND POWERHOUSE**

A side track is to be constructed directly opposite the Christmas Island Powerhouse, to facilitate work to take place on installing a pipeline from the Smith Point IOCC installation directly to the storage tanks on Murray Road.

Also installed in the trench there will be a high voltage cable which will provide power to the CIP dryer facility

An unsealed side track will be constructed to take road users around the proposed work. This side track, which will only be a short one of about 100m long will be kept watered daily to improve visibility in all conditions. The work, which is scheduled to commence on **Monday 17th April**, will take about a month to complete. This project is an incentive of the IOCC, and has been initiated by the need for a smoother transfer of fuel from the landing/unloading facility at Smith Point.
