**OVERSIZE LOAD MOVEMENTS**

There are planned movements of prefabricated construction equipment that are to be transported from the wharf to LB4 on Murray Road, this is to be carried out by CIP on the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> of May, during daylight hours. Murray Road will be closed every two hours for just two or three minutes between Silver City Road and Phosphate Hill Road.

The closure will be controlled by CIP personnel, and the trucks will be escorted by CIP vehicles with flashing beacons. School bus times will be respected and the operation will cease while the buses are active. It is also expected that a police vehicle with the customary red and blue flashing lights will head each group. Each group will only be on the road for a short time, say every two hours.
